Role Summary: Work closely with Founder, other colleagues, vendors and stakeholders to successfully develop and launch company's first software product, BuildingGenius, a B2B SaaS platform ("product"). Grow from Associate Product Manager into Product Manager who will take on more ownership of vision and strategy.

Responsibilities

Core Role

- 1. Work with Founder to understand their vision for the product and refine requirements:
 - a. Gain knowledge about the housing industry's primary stakeholders, project development process, environmental impacts, policy history, knowledge product competitors, trends, and challenges
 - b. Grow to understand BuildingGenius target users' range of profiles, painpoints and value propositions; map customer lifecycle processes
 - c. Review and understand overarching product strategy, business plan and related opportunities
 - d. Review work plan outline and offer feedback; finalize tasks, timelines and milestones
- Create buy-in for the product vision both internally and with outside partners, coordinate implementation from cross-functional team, and hold others accountable in their roles
- 3. Manage in-house team resources, coordinate content development, and coordinate other activities handled by external vendors
- 4. Review and refine draft beta testing plan; identify, monitor and report on KPIs for beta phase, including methods of assessment and actions to take if targets are missed; execute beta and support beta users
- 5. Assess the following from beta testing phase: 1) product market fit, 2) viability of MVP and current SaaS platform for public launch, and 3) pricing model for launch
- 6. Review, update and maintain financial plan including expenses, pricing model and revenue targets
- 7. Expand on conceptual marketing and outreach plan and coordinate implementation activities with colleagues
- 8. Evolve product priorities and work plans based on beta user feedback, new trends and opportunities, etc.
- 9. Design and execute product launch plan
- 10. Develop post-launch maintenance and growth plan

- 12. Outline work plans prior to starting work, maintain logically organized and labeled files, and adequately document decisions or activities
